AFFIANT'S STATEMENT OF MITIGATING FACTS:

1. Filer states that he left office due to several traumatic brain injuries. Additionally, after leaving office, he contracted COVID-19 twice and suffered chronic side effects.

STAFF'S ANALYSIS OF FACTS FOR COMMISSION REVIEW

1. Mr. Welch served as a municipal officer for the city of North Pole and was required to complete a final POFD statement no later than 90 days after leaving office.

Reduced to 50% of maximum under 2 AAC 50.855(b)(1)(C).

- 2. Mr. Welch resigned as Mayor on June 17, 2024, before his term expiration date.
- 3. APOC was not notified of Mr. Welch's resignation and as such, staff was unable to send a courtesy notice of his final filing requirement nor was staff able to timely issue a delinquency notice when he failed to file his final POFD statement.
- 4. Based on his good filing history, the fact that Mr. Welch did not receive timely notice of his delinquency, and his ongoing medical issues, staff recommends a waiver of the penalty.

Mr. Welch:

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According to our records you did not timely file your Final Public Official Financial Disclosure (POFD) Statement that was due on September 16, 2024. Instead, your statement was filed on November 20, 2024 (65 days late). By law, a maximum penalty of \$10 accrues each day the report is late. The maximum penalty the Alaska Public Offices Commission (APOC) could assess you is \$650.2

However, regulation allows APOC staff to document the violation and reduce the assessed penalty to 50% of the maximum.³ Accordingly, the assessed penalty owed is \$325.

Additionally, please be advised:

You may pay the reduced penalty and avoid formal Commission action by remitting payment by check or money order payable to the State of Alaska to the Alaska Public Offices Commission at the address above; visiting our website to make a payment by credit card; or you may pay in cash at our offices. Payment must be made within thirty days of the date of this letter. If you are unable to pay the entire assessed penalty in a single payment and wish to discuss a payment plan, or have any other questions concerning this matter, please contact the APOC staff.

Alternatively, you have the right to appeal staff's conclusion that a violation has occurred, or the reduced penalty amount assessed.⁵ If you wish to appeal you must submit the enclosed appeal affidavit to APOC within thirty days of the date of this letter.
