Heather Hebdon summarized the complaint history and its alleged violations. Complainant Lynne Cameron appeared telephonically and gave a statement in support of expedited consideration. Respondent Daniel Henry appeared telephonically and gave a statement in opposition of expedited consideration.

**Commissioner Clift seconded the motion.**

**Complainant and Respondent agreed to waive the two-day requirement for hearing.**
