Other Relevant Dates for the 2010 Primary Election:

Friday, July 23, 2010, (33 days prior to the date of the August 24, 2010 Primary Election)

The last day that a candidate may give or loan their campaign more than \$5000.

Friday, October 8, 2010, (45 days after the date of the Primary Election)

The last day a candidate may accept contributions.

Monday, November 22, 2010 (90 days after the date of the Primary Election)

The date by which candidates must disburse the amount held in their campaign account.

Other Relevant Dates for the 2010 General Election:

Friday, October 1, 2010, (33 days prior to the date of the November 2, 2010 General Election)

The last day that a candidate may give or loan their campaign more than \$5000.

Friday, December 17, 2010, (45 days after the date of the General Election)

The last day a candidate may accept contributions.

February 1, 2011

The date by which candidates must disburse the amount held in their campaign account.

***NOTE: 24 Hour Reports:** During the 9 days before an election, you must report the contributor name and amount of all monetary and non-monetary contributions over \$250 to the APOC within 24 hours of the time you receive each contribution. You may need to report each day during that period or not at all. You must fax, hand-carry or, after hours call in the report. Do not mail 24 Hour Reports.
