Enterprise Technology Services Results Delivery Unit

Contribution to Department's Mission

Provide telephone, network, data center and data processing services to the executive branch of Alaska State government, and similar support services to other branches of Alaska State and Federal government for the benefit of Alaskans.

Major RDU Accomplishments in 2012

- Designed and implemented a private, State-owned cloud-hosting architecture capable of providing redundant, geographically disperse hosting services to the State including data center fail-over/fail-back functionality for Disaster Recovery. This deployed earned the Government Information Technology Executive Council (GITEC) Project Excellence Award in the area of "Shared IT Services: Concept to Implementation".
- Successfully moved the Anchorage Data Center to a "lights out" facility collocated with GCI at the South Anchorage Data Center (SADC); relocated offices to refurbished space in the Bayview Building; and decommissioned the Fairbanks Street data center after 30 years' occupancy.
- Performed FCC-mandated Narrowbanding throughout the state for the departments of Public Safety, Natural Resources, Environmental Conservation, Corrections, Health and Social Services, Transportation/Public Facilities (including the ferry system and the Whittier Tunnel).
- Bandwidth was upgraded in the core communities of Juneau and Anchorage from 10 Mbps (speed) to 20Mbps, effectively doubling speed. Ketchikan bandwidth was upgraded from 10 Mbps to 20 Mbps.
- Completed the WSUS (Windows Server Update Service) project with deployment of regional update servers that will increase efficiencies and thereby significantly improve bandwidth performance.

Key RDU Challenges

ETS Organization - The division reorganized structurally and functionally to improve its customer-focused mission and goals, and continues work to create understandable and relevant rate structures. Inroads toward better consolidation and a significant demonstration of true disaster capability were accomplished over the prior period, with the successful relocation of the Anchorage Data Center, and deployment of a new secure, multi-tenant infrastructure platform available to all state agencies.

Lack of Consolidation - The wide variety of supported data locations, software and data formats continue to drive increases in complexity and costs of operation for all agencies. Maintaining disparate systems in multiple, sometimes unknown locations results in security risks and higher costs for the state. The recently-deployed secure multi-tenant infrastructure provides a cost-effective path toward decreased complexity and increased consolidation.

Bandwidth - Bandwidth required to conduct Alaska state business is currently insufficient. This creates service delays as well as increased costs for customer agencies and their constituents. Demand for increased bandwidth is expected to rise.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2014

Bandwidth - Negotiations are underway with commercial carriers to provide increased bandwidth for the minimum cost available. Additional efforts are underway to take advantage of network acceleration technology and to reduce unnecessary network traffic through a variety of means. The division will deploy data and voice circuit management hardware and software, which will help our division and other agencies, manage consumption and control costs.

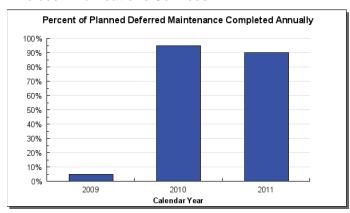

Major Component Accomplishments in 2012

- Significantly increased the Department of Natural Resource's firefighting dispatch capabilities, by installing new dispatch consoles and associated network infrastructure in Fairbanks, Tok and Delta Junction.
- Upgraded microwave network capacity, fault tolerance and alarm reporting for 296 sites.
- Sunset aging statewide paging service in favor of short message service (SMS) texting to cellular phones or email notification.
- Performed FCC-mandated Narrowbanding throughout the state for the departments of Public Safety, Natural Resources, Environmental Conservation, Corrections, Health and Social Services, Transportation/Public Facilities (including the ferry system and the Whittier Tunnel).

Key Component Challenges

The State of Alaska Telecommunications System (SATS) provides critical network infrastructure along the Interior road system, in Prince William Sound, and areas of Southeast Alaska. SATS towers are often necessarily found in remote locations.

Deferred Maintenance - Completing deferred maintenance work in the face of challenging travel and weather issues remains a key challenge. This critical work is essential to assure the integrity of the state's Wide Area Network (WAN) and public safety wireless communications.

FCC 2013 Narrowbanding Federal Mandate - Technicians continue to work on upgrading sites that must meet the FCC-mandated Narrowbanding requirements to be completed by January 1, 2013. SATS has also assisted other

agencies in meeting their Narrowbanding requirements through Reimbursable Services Agreements, in order for those agencies to meet the mandate deadline.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2014

Deferred Maintenance - Major upgrades continue on SATS systems under the auspices of a five-year funding plan to perform long-deferred maintenance. FY2014 will be the fourth year of this five-year plan, with another \$3,000,000 of planned maintenance to be performed.

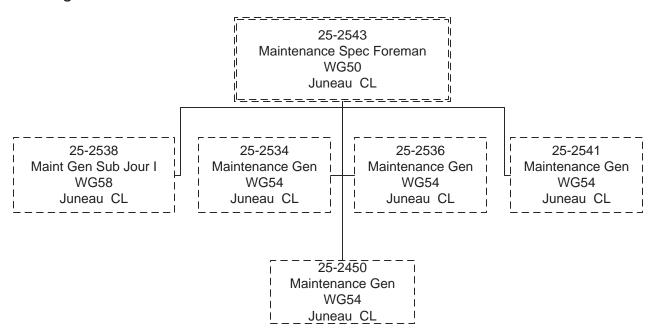

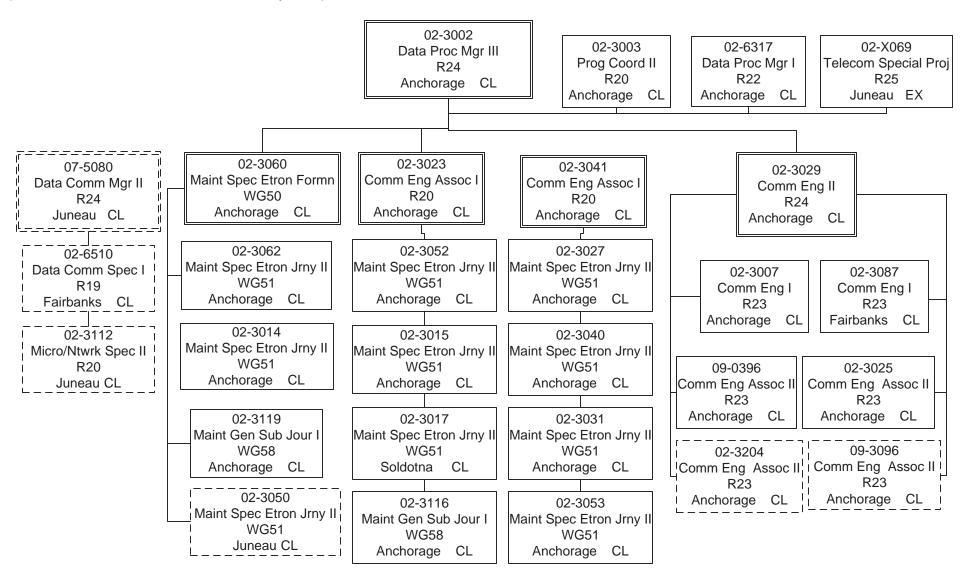

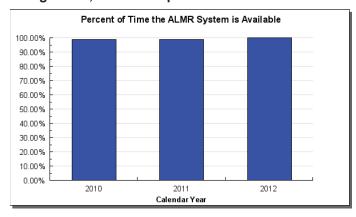

Major Component Accomplishments in 2012

- 1,483 new subscribers were added, bringing the total to 22,156 subscribers on the system.
- 11,152,069 total voice calls were processed during FY2012.
- The state received the remaining ALMR site infrastructure from the Department of Defense (total of 41 sites received during this divestiture).
- Through the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs, ALMR provided training throughout the state.

Key Component Challenges

Funding - The Alaska Land Mobile Radio (ALMR) System is governed and financed under a Consortium Agreement among the State of Alaska, the Department of Defense (DoD), and Non-DoD Federal agencies in Alaska. Annual operational and maintenance costs are allocated across consortium members and system users based on a Cost Share Agreement, by all consortium members. Annual operating expenses are dependent on all consortium members securing their share of project costs from their authorizing budget authorities. Currently, ALMR is funded from State and DoD funds. A critical, on-going challenge for ALMR is securing the necessary annual operating funds across all consortium members.

Army ALMR Site Divesture - In January of 2012, the U.S. Army divested 13 ALMR sites to the State of Alaska. An additional 28 sites were divested to the State in July of 2012. These divestitures have resulted in increased maintenance costs for the state. The State of Alaska Telecommunications (SATS) component has absorbed both the maintenance and staffing expenses in order to maintain ALMR services at their accustomed levels.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2014

ALMR Sites - Our system will continue to be maintained and provide excellent service to its customers. The division will work with the ALMR Consortium partners to identify customer requirements, communicate technology trends, set policy and establish long-range plans for public safety wireless communications.

ALMR System Update - A major system update project commenced in August of 2012. The current system software is no longer supported by the manufacturer. As a result, system security and anti-virus patches are no longer available for the system. A multi-million dollar software and hardware update will bring the system to the latest software release, as well as cover the system under a software assurance program. The update project will take approximately nine (9) months and will result in minor disruptions to the system.

Interoperability Partnership - Our system provides 2-way radio interoperability throughout the state. ALMR and the Municipality of Anchorage's (MOA's)-Anchorage Wide Area Radio Network (AWARN) system run on similar system architecture. The MOA did not request funding from the legislature for their portion of the upgrade. As a result, it is unclear whether interoperability between the systems can be maintained in the near term. In the longer term, MOA expects to request funding to upgrade its system, assuring future interoperability.

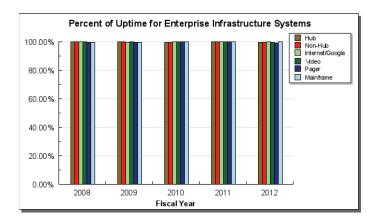

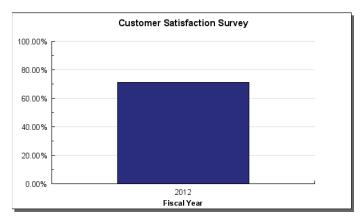

Major Component Accomplishments in 2012

- Deployed the Enterprise MS-SQL server which will bring cost savings, and will eventually extend savings opportunities to future MS-SQL-as-a-Service customers.
- myAlaska version 3 went live October 12, 2011. Since then 452,817 unique user accounts have logged into the
 myAlaska to access one or more of the 43 agency applications available, such as applying for their PFDs online,
 access Alaska student aid, and Department of Environmental Conservation online services.
- Designed and implemented a private, state-owned, infrastructure platform (FlexPod) capable of providing redundant, geographically diverse hosting services to the State including data center fail-over/fail-back functionality for Disaster Recovery. This deployment earned the Government Information Technology Executive Council (GITEC) Project Excellence Award in the area of "Shared IT Services: Concept to Implementation".
- Central Processing Unit Capacity upgrade for the Mainframe was completed successfully, concurrently with no interruption to service. This upgrade was required to support customer's increased usage.
- Upgraded bandwidth speed and capacity for Anchorage and Juneau in tandem with the Anchorage Data Center Move, which also required moving the entire Anchorage Network Operations Center. Ketchikan Bandwidth was upgraded from 10 Mbps to 20 Mbps, effectively doubling both speed and capacity.
- Decommissioned Fairbanks Street facility, including removal and/or migration of 30 years' of technology infrastructure.

Key Component Challenges

Security - Securing the state's information and technology systems is a key challenge for the division. Successful deployment of security initiatives that assure protection of the state's information assets, without disrupting services, is very complicated. Educating users on the appropriate measures they can take to ensure secure systems is critical.

Network Improvements - Network improvements and bandwidth upgrades to support services across the state Wide Area Network (WAN) are continually added to provide the robust, reliable yet flexible systems needed to carry out business operations across the state government. Upgrades will be completed that will enhance network environments, security services, and digital telephony. Regular upgrades to the system and continuing education for technical staff are essential.

Bandwidth Upgrades - Multiple services are provided online, with agencies adding more all the time, resulting in a continual increase in bandwidth capacity need. Rural broadband capacity needs will continue to be addressed through standardization, methods for compressing data and eliminating data backhaul through caching.

Communication - Effective communication of enterprise services to state agencies is a key component in achieving economies of scale for similar efforts. Keeping the communication lines open allows agencies to focus on their primary business goals while remaining informed of technology developments that may improve methods of accomplishing these goals.

Recruitment and Retention of Qualified Staff - A major challenge to the enterprise and individual agencies is the difficulty in recruiting and retaining individuals with skill sets necessary to work on the various older systems that are essential to conducting the state's business.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2014

Legacy Systems – The division will work to design and develop a road-map that will assist in pulling together a plan for modernizing obsolete systems, increased security, audit requirements and compliance, as well as using innovation to reduce the overall costs, and meeting legal mandates.
