



FUEL CELL POWER UNITS

Alaska is an active member of WSCA. In order to use a WSCA contract, the state must sign a Participating Addendum (PA).

If the state has not signed a Participating Addendum for one of the vendors listed in the table below and you would like to work with that vendor, please notify the contracting officer listed at the bottom of this page.

WSCA has established the following non-mandatory contracts with providers of Fuel Cell Power Units. The fuel cell power units, components, and accessories provide back-up power for both indoor and outdoor stationary applications. These systems will cover a range of 1kW to 30kW. Only Proton Exchange Membrane fuel cells (PEM or PEMFC) also known as Polymer Electrolyte Membrane fuel cells are included.
