



## PROCUREMENT ANALYSIS CONSULTING SERVICES

The Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA) leverages the buying power of 15 western states to offer exceptional pricing for participating states and their political subdivisions. Alaska is an active member of WSCA. In order to use a WSCA contract, the state must sign a Participating Addendum (PA).

Due to the unique nature of the Procurement Analysis Consulting contract, the State of Alaska has not signed a PA. In order to utilize this contract, the following procedure must occur.

1. Interested agency or political subdivision submits a Scope of Work to the Contracting Manager listed below.
2. The Contracting Manager will submit the Scope of Work to the WSCA Lead State.
3. The WSCA Lead State conducts a mini-proposal among a pre-qualified vendor pool. The using agency or political subdivision performs the evaluation of proposals with WSCA Lead State assistance.
4. Upon determination of the winning vendor, the State of Alaska will sign a PA with the vendor and the project can then move forward.

WSCA has identified and selected 20 highly qualified vendors to perform services in nine distinct categories. It must be noted that each vendor may or may not be included in each category.
