Alaska is an active member of WSCA. In order to use a WSCA contract, the state must sign a Participating Addendum (PA).

WSCA has established the following non-mandatory contracts with providers of Vehicle Tires, Tubes, and Services. The contracts offer a wide range of vehicle tires from the pursuit and performance, passenger, light duty truck, medium commercial, off-road, industrial and specialty tire categories. In addition, a range of low rolling resistance tires are also available. A variety of tires services are also provided through the contracts
