Section A - Definition of Taxable Gross Weight.

The Internal Revenue Service Regulations define "taxable gross weight" as the sum of **ALL** of the following:

- 1) The actual unloaded weight of the vehicle.
- 2) The actual unloaded weight of any trailers or semi-trailers customarily used in combination with this vehicle.
- 3) The weight of the maximum load customarily carried on such vehicle and on any trailer or semi-trailer customarily used in combination with this vehicle.

Section B - Declaration

I, the undersigned, certify under penalty of law that the vehicle(s) listed above or on the attached pages have a taxable gross weight, as defined in section A, of less than 55,000 pounds. I understand that fraudulent use of this form will subject the undersigned, or any other party making such fraudulent use, to criminal penalties, which may include fines and/or imprisonment together with the costs of prosecution.
