**NOTICE OF COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSE (CDL)  
OFF-HIGHWAY RESTRICTION REMOVAL**

Dear CDL driver,

This letter is being sent to you because you hold an off-highway commercial driver license (CDL). The Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) issues off-highway CDLs, which exempts an individual from the commercial road skills testing requirement, to individuals who operate commercial motor vehicles in an area where:

- Such roads are not connected by land highway or vehicular way to the land-connected State highway system; and
- Such roads are not connected to any highway or vehicular way with an average daily traffic volume greater than 499.

The community of King Salmon no longer qualifies for this exemption. All CDL holders with a "7" restriction printed on their license must pass a CDL road skills test or voluntarily surrender the CDL license. CDL holders that do not comply within 120 days from the date of this letter will be subject to license cancellation per Alaska Statute 28.15.161. King salmon

Before you may take a CDL road skills test you **must** have a commercial permit issued to you and hold the permit for at least 14 days. Because you currently hold an off system CDL a written test will not be required to obtain the permit. Please visit your local DMV office to have the permit issued to you at no fee at least 14 days prior to skills testing. CDL road skills tests can be set up by going into your local Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) office with this letter or using its on-line road test scheduling.

If you have a hazmat endorsement, you must apply for a background check and receive approval from the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) before taking your CDL road skills test. For information regarding the TSA background check please visit the DMV's web site at:
