



The Municipality of Anchorage Department of Health & Human Services would like to remind you of important information regarding the Emissions Inspection (I/M) program:

As of March 1, 2012, I/M tests are no longer required for vehicle registration.

Vehicle owners in the Municipality of Anchorage and those who commute into Anchorage are no longer required to have their vehicles undergo an I/M test (vehicle inspection and maintenance) prior to registration. This ends a requirement that has been in place since 1985 to reduce carbon monoxide (CO) air pollution.

Anchorage has not violated federal standards for CO since 1996. Although I/M played a significant role in reducing CO emissions from vehicles, it has become less important as the emission control technology in cars and trucks has improved over the years. This January, the EPA approved the discontinuation of I/M after concluding that it is no longer necessary to maintain compliance with the CO standard.
