

MANDATORY LIABILITY INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS VEHICLE, SNOWMACHINE & ATV

Vehicles, snowmachines and ATVs driven on Kotzebue's public roads MUST be covered by an insurance policy. This includes vehicles being driven in from surrounding communities in the NANA Region.

The registered owner is required to certify that there is a liability policy in effect at the time of registration and that the vehicle will not be driven without insurance. The registered owner will certify to this statement by signing the registration form.

If the owner does not sign the certification, the DMV may not register the vehicle. The insurance policy must have the following minimum amounts:

- • \$50,000 for bodily injury or death of any one person
- • \$100,000 for bodily injury or death for any accident
- • \$25,000 for property damage

Proof of motor vehicle liability insurance must be in the driver's possession at all times when driving a motor vehicle, snowmachine or ATV on Kotzebue public roads.

(CAUTION: Some insurance policies for the operation of snowmachines and ATVs only provide liability coverage for operation of snowmachines and ATVs on private property and off-road use. This type of insurance for off-road use and private property does not meet the mandatory insurance requirements effective January 1, 2012.)

Failure to have the proper insurance may result in a suspension of your driver license.
