Due to paperwork requirements, Veterans' plates cannot be ordered over the Internet. Commemorative Veteran and Support our Troops plates can be ordered over the Internet, as these plates are available to any Alaska resident.

The plate must contain a minimum of two (2) characters and a maximum of six (6) characters, or characters and spaces combined. If a space is requested it will eliminate one character choice. All requests will be centered unless otherwise requested. Symbols (dashes, commas, slashes, etc.) may not be ordered on these plates. Please give careful consideration before requesting your plates as we do not refund personalized plate fees.

To distinguish between an "O" and a "0" (zero) place a slash (/) through the 0 when requesting a zero (Ø).

Your vehicle must be currently registered in ALASKA, in your name, prior to submitting an application. Please do not allow your vehicle registration to expire prior to receiving your plates. DO NOT ORDER PLATES IF YOU PLAN ON SELLING YOUR VEHICLE WITHIN THE NEXT 3 MONTHS. If you sell the vehicle, notify DMV immediately by sending a message to: DOA.DMV.Webmaster@Alaska.gov

A copy of the current Alaska registration and payment (personalized check or money order payable to State of Alaska) for plate fees must accompany the application.

Please see the specific plate information below for fees and additional requirements.

VETERAN PLATES: (Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marine, or Navy)

- These plates may only be issued to vehicles that are solely or jointly owned by a veteran or retired veteran of the armed forces of the United States. You must provide a copy of your DD-214 or current Military ID.
- Plate Fee: \$30.00
- The veteran must sign the application and only the veteran may transfer the plates to another vehicle.

ALASKA NATIONAL GUARD:

- These plates may only be issued to vehicles that are solely or jointly owned by an active member of the Alaska National Guard. You must provide proof of service, such as an Army or Air Force Identification Card.
- Plate Fee: \$30.00
- Make a statement in the affidavit or comments section of the application stating that you are a member of the Alaska National Guard.
- The guard member must sign the application and may transfer the plates to another vehicle.

GOLD STAR FAMILY:

- These plates may only be issued to a vehicle that is solely or jointly owned by the spouse, parent, guardian, sibling or child of a service member of the United States armed forces who was killed in the line of duty.
- One plate is allowed per family member.
- You must provide a Report of Casualty (DD Form 1300) and any further documentation to provide proof that you are directly related to the service member.
- The family member must sign the application and may transfer the plates to another vehicle.

LAO VETERAN

- Plate Fee \$30.00
- These plates may only be issued to vehicles that are solely or jointly owned by veterans of military operations in support of the United States in the Kingdom of Laos between February 28, 1961, and May 15, 1975.
- The member must sign the application and may transfer the plates to another vehicle.

OTHER MILITARY PLATES:

In addition to the plates shown above, the Division of Motor Vehicles issues the following types of license plates. These plates are not personalized at the present time. Please contact the DMV for information on requirements that must be met in order to obtain any of the following types of plates:

- Disabled Veteran, Purple Heart, Prisoner of War and Pearl Harbor Survivor.

The fees for the following plates are used to support veterans' programs. The additional registration fee is charged when the plates are first ordered, along with each registration renewal
