AFFIDAVIT FOR AN ESTATE WITH ASSETS OF \$150,000 OR LESS

This affidavit may only be used when the entire estate, wherever located, less liens and encumbrances, has a value of \$150,000 or less. In addition, the total value of all vehicles can not exceed \$100,000 and the total value of personal property, excluding the vehicles, can not exceed \$50,000. The vehicle must be titled in the name listed above before it can be sold to another person. An original affidavit is required for each vehicle. AS 13.16.680(a)

I certify under penalty of law that the information contained in this affidavit is true and correct, including but not limited to all of the following statements:

- I am the successor of the estate of the person listed above and I am entitled to the vehicle.
- 30 days have elapsed since the death of the owner.
- No application or petition for the appointment of a personal representative is pending or has been granted in any jurisdiction.

Additional Information:

- If the total value of the vehicles owned exceeds \$100,000 or if the personal property, excluding the vehicle(s) exceeds \$50,000, this form cannot be used. Letters Testamentary are required.
- Only the successor of the estate may apply for a title.

Items required:

- Affidavit for an Estate with Assets of \$150,000 or less (Form 827)
- Application for Title and Registration (Form 812). You must obtain a title in your name before you can sell the vehicle.
- Original title, properly released.
- If the title cannot be found, a notarized Affidavit of Lost, Stolen or Destroyed title is required. You would need to obtain a title in the name of the decedent before you can change the title to your name.
- A copy of the last registration issued, if available
- \$15.00 to obtain a title. Other fees if vehicle is not currently registered.
