At separation of State service, your terminal leave payment will be taxed by one of two methods:

- 1. Terminal leave payments will be taxed at the withholding rate you have previously requested for your payroll wages if the payout is combined with your final payroll wages, or
- 2. Per IRS regulations, the terminal leave payment will be taxed at a flat 22% rate if issued on a separate warrant from your final payroll wages.

This form only needs to be completed if you elect to have your terminal leave payment issued on a separate warrant from your final payroll wages and taxed at the 22% flat rate. Please indicate this option by completing and signing the form below.

This form must be received by your Payroll department along with your completed separation packet/forms prior to your last day worked.
