




## Crossword Puzzle: IRIS Terminology



### DOWN

1. **Dimension** - A term often used with chart of account structures that can apply to an element, sub element, or rollup.
2. **Hierarchy** - A tree-type relationship among a series of chart of account elements where one element, a parent, is broken down into smaller components called children. It is one of the types of structures available in IRIS.
4. **Fund** - The Chart of Accounts element that represents a self-balancing set of accounts.

### ACROSS

3. **Inference** - The process by which codes are automatically brought into documents when combinations of other codes are used. An example is: Supply the code for the Task Order and have the Program and Phase codes populated automatically.
5. **Rollup** - A grouping of chart of account element codes for reporting or control purposes. Most COA elements use element class, category, types, and group to roll information into higher levels of summarization.
