To take action on minutes from earlier meetings, to review outstanding ethics cases, to consider the adoption of proposed amendments to Personnel Rules, and other matters that may come before the board within the scope of this notice.

Amendments are proposed to the following Personnel Rules and are necessary to implement recently passed legislation (HB 417), chapter 21, SLA 2008, amending AS 39.20.080(b) and 39.27.011. The proposed amendments address the compensation authorized for a deputy head of a principal executive department and pay increments for longevity in state service and make changes to

- 2 AAC 07.316. Salary for deputy heads of a principal department
- 2 AAC 07.330. Salary for promoted employees
- 2 AAC 07.331. Exceptions for initial appointments of an employee to a new job class
- 2 AAC 07.345. Demoted employees' salaries
- 2 AAC 07.349. Exception for initial appointment subject to personnel rules
- 2 AAC 07.365. Merit or longevity increases
- 2 AAC 07.375. Withdrawing a salary step
