

**ASSIGNMENT to 4-DAY WORK SCHEDULE

The work schedule shall consist of four consecutive workdays within the defined workweek*, which begins on (day of week) Monday at midnight and ends on the following (day of week) Monday at midnight.

*The workweek should begin at midnight of the third regular day off (RDO).

Management reserves the right to alter this schedule, when necessary, to meet the business needs of the workplace with consideration of the employee's needs, in accordance with the collective bargaining agreement.

This assignment shall be effective on Tuesday, May 3, 2016 and shall remain in effect through June 30, 2018 (no later than June 30, 2018). Either party may cancel upon fifteen calendar (15) days written notice, with concurrent notice to the Payroll Services Manager. In the event of cancellation, the affected employee shall return to a normal work schedule in the first week following the required notice period.
