

INDIVIDUAL LETTER OF AGREEMENT
between the
STATE OF ALASKA
and the
ALASKA STATE EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION
representing the
GENERAL GOVERNMENT UNIT

Re: Seasonal Fish & Wildlife Technicians, Travel/Per Diem
LOA 10-GG-219

It is agreed between the parties that the following terms and conditions of employment apply to seasonal Department of Fish and Game, Fish and Wildlife Technician positions in Aniak, Pilot Station, St. Mary's, Goodnews Bay and Quinhagak field camps. No provision of the July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2013, master agreement not specifically referenced herein is modified by this agreement.

This agreement amends Article 30 to allow the Department to pay for lodging and Meal and Incidental allowance for the incumbents of those seasonal positions located in these remote locations on days that camps are inhabitable. The Employer will determine the duration of the allowance.

This agreement supersedes LOA 08-GG-158 and expires June 30, 2013, except that it may be canceled by either party within fifteen (15) calendar days written notice.

This agreement is entered into solely to address the specific circumstance of this particular situation. It does not establish any practice or precedent between the parties. This agreement shall not be referred to in any other dispute, grievance, arbitration, hearing, or any other forum, except as may be necessary for the execution of its terms.
