

**LETTER OF AGREEMENT**  
between the  
**STATE OF ALASKA**  
and the  
**PUBLIC SAFETY EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION**

Deputy Fire Marshall I, Work Assignment


It is agreed between the parties that the following terms and conditions of employment apply to Deputy Fire Marshal I (DFM I) positions within the Department of Public Safety (Department). No provision of the July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2014 master agreement not specifically referenced is modified by this agreement.

1. Deputy Fire Marshal I positions will be scheduled for standby throughout the year.
2. Standby scheduling will be subject to the following:
  - A. DFM I standby assignments will include RDOs.
  - B. Compensation for standby assignments and hours worked shall be pursuant to CBA Article 15.
  - C. Given the limited number of DFM I positions throughout the state, should a DFM I be called to the scene, the following guidelines will apply.
    - i. The sequence of calls will be made in order of geographic proximity to the scene.
    - ii. The closest available DFM I to the scene will be notified and asked to respond.
    - iii. If the closest DFM I is not available, the next closest DFM I will be called and asked to respond.
    - iv. If the DFM I's closest to the scene are not available to respond, the standby DFM I will be notified and asked to respond.
    - v. If it becomes necessary for the DFM I to travel to the scene, the Department will provide travel compensation pursuant to CBA Article 8 and the Alaska Administrative Manual (Division of Finance).
  - D. This agreement shall be effective upon signing and remain in effect unless

specifically canceled by either party with thirty (30) days written notice.

This agreement is entered into solely to address the specific circumstance of this particular situation. It does not establish any practice or precedent between the parties. This agreement shall not be referred to in any other dispute, grievance, arbitration, hearing, or any other forum, except as may be necessary for the execution of its terms.
