

LETTER OF AGREEMENT
between the
STATE OF ALASKA

Unlicensed Crew

Re: Bumping between systems during RIF

It is agreed between the parties that the following terms and conditions of employment apply to members of the Inlandboatmen's Union working for the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities. No provisions of the July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2014 Master Agreement specifically referenced herein are modified by this agreement.

1. During RIF, Displaced Regularly Assigned Employees (DRAE) and Relief employees may request to work in the region (Southwest or Southeast) other than the region in which they hold their bid. Once a written request has been received, and no job positions in the job classification in the designated region exists, bumping between regions will be allowed.
2. There shall be no additional cost to the State directly related to this option. For example, but not limited to, entitlements under Rule 11, Rule 12.04 and 12.05 shall not apply.
3. This agreement is effective November 24, 2012 and shall be coterminous with the 2011-2014 agreement.

This agreement may be cancelled by either party with fifteen (15) days written notice.
