

LETTER OF AGREEMENT

Re: Rule 17.06 lump sum

14-II-270

This agreement is entered to address specific issues relating to the provisions of Rule 17.06, annual lump sum payment of eighty-four (84) straight time hours. All provisions of the Master Agreement not specifically mentioned or clarified below shall remain in effect.

Rule 17.06 shall be amended as follows:

An employee who establishes eligibility for vacation under Rule 23.02 (B) will, seven (7) years after establishing such eligibility, begin receiving an annual lump sum payment equal to eighty-four (84) times that employee's straight-time hourly rate.

This agreement is effective upon signing.

It is entered into solely to address the specific circumstances of this particular situation. It does not establish any practice or precedent between the parties. The parties agree that this agreement will not be referred to in any other dispute, grievance, arbitration, hearing or any other forum, except as may be necessary for the execution of its terms.
