

LETTER OF AGREEMENT
between the

Article 25 – Alternate Work Week Defined

15-SS-229

It is agreed between the parties that the following terms and conditions of employment shall apply to all members of the Alaska Public Employees Association, Supervisory Unit. No provision of the July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2016, master agreement not specifically referenced is modified by this agreement.

1. If an employee is working an approved Alternative Work Week (AWW), the parties agree that the employee's start and end days for their "workweek" will be defined per the employee's individual AWW agreement.

This agreement is effective December 16, 2014 and remains in effect through June 30, 2016. This agreement is entered into solely to address the specific circumstances of this particular situation. It does not establish any practice or precedent between the parties. This agreement shall not be referred to in any other dispute, grievance, arbitration, hearing, or any other forum, except as may be necessary for the execution of its terms.
