It is agreed and understood between the parties that the following terms and conditions of employment apply to all Supervisory Unit full-time employees in the Health Practitioner job classifications, whose positions are located within the Department of Corrections, Inmate Health Section. No provision of the July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2016, master agreement not specifically referenced is modified by this agreement.

1. DOC Health Practitioners who attend Employer approved training on their regular days off will have seven and one-half (7.5) hours of personal leave credited to their leave account, for each full day of training. No other compensation or benefit will accrue as a result of attending such training on the employee's regular days off. However, travel, if any, will be paid in accordance with the Alaska Administrative Manual.
2. In order for the employee to receive the leave, the training must have advance supervisory approval, the training day must be of at least seven (7) hours duration, and the employee must attend and participate fully in the training.

This agreement is effective upon signing, and remains in effect through June 30, 2016, except that it may be canceled by either party with fifteen (15) days written notice.

This agreement is entered into solely to address the specific circumstances of this particular situation. It does not establish any practice or precedent between the parties. This agreement shall not be referred to in any other dispute, grievance, arbitration, hearing, negotiation, or any other forum, except as may be necessary for the execution of its terms.
