

Notice of Personnel Board Meeting

The Alaska State Personnel Board will hold a meeting on October 6, 2010, starting at 12:00 p.m., in Room 880 at the Frontier Building, 3601 C Street, Anchorage, Alaska, pursuant to authority vested in it under AS 39.25.070 on the following matters:

To take action on minutes from earlier meetings, to review outstanding ethics cases and reports, to consider the adoption of proposed amendments to Personnel Rules, to review proposals submitted in response to RFP 2011-0200-9777 and other matters that may come before the board within the scope of this notice. The review of proposals and deliberations on ethics matters will occur in executive session because these matters are required to be confidential under AS 36.30.230 and AS 39.52.340 respectively.

The proposed amendments to the Personnel Rules are as follows:

2 AAC 07.390 is amended by eliminating language requiring that compensatory time to be cashed out to the employee at the end of the leave year; adding language that establishes maximums for compensatory time and adding language that specifies how an employee will be paid once the maximum is reached.

After the close of the public comment period, the Personnel Board in its discretion will either adopt these or other proposals dealing with the same subject, without further notice, or decide to

take no action on them. The language of the final regulations may vary from that of the proposed regulations. You should comment during the time allowed if your interests could be affected.


