Supervisory Unit (SS)

Description: A statewide unit of classified, supervisory employees of the Executive Branch. A supervisory employee is an individual, regardless of job description or title, who has authority to act or to effectively recommend action in the interest of the public employer in any one of the following supervisory functions, if the exercise of that authority is not merely routine but requires the exercise of independent judgment: employing, including hiring, transferring, laying off, or recalling; discipline, including suspending discharging, demoting, or issuing written warnings; or grievance adjudication, including responding to a first level grievance under a collective bargaining agreement.
