

A Welcome Kit. Be on the lookout for a Welcome Kit to be mailed in mid-June which will include:

- Contact information for Wells Fargo Insurance Services and the other AlaskaCare partners
- Claim forms, claim filing instructions, and other information on using the AlaskaCare plans
- Prescription Drug information, including instructions for obtaining medication through the mail-order program

ID Cards for you and your family members. These will be mailed in late June. You will continue to use your existing ID cards for all doctor visits and pharmacy refills until July 1, 2009.

At the moment, nothing! Just sit tight and wait for your Welcome Kit and ID cards to arrive.
