

## Public Hearing

### STATE OF ALASKA Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission

Re: The Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (AOGCC) acting pursuant to AS 31.05.030, hereby gives notice of a Public Hearing to seek comments in Docket OTH-10-16 concerning whether changes or additions may be needed to the AOGCC's regulations governing drilling, rig workover and well control in offshore and ultra-extended reach wells drilled in areas of the State of Alaska under the AOGCC's jurisdiction.

The AOGCC gave notice on June 25, 2010 that following issuance of the Report to the President from the National Commission on the BP Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill and Offshore Drilling (National Commission) it would convene a public hearing to review and assess the adequacy of Alaska's relevant Statutes and Regulations. The National Commission issued its report on January 11, 2011. Accordingly, the Commission hereby gives notice that it will hold a public hearing on this inquiry on May 11, 2011 beginning at the hour of 9:00 a.m. The hearing will be held in the hearing room of the AOGCC, 333 West 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Suite 100, Anchorage, Alaska 99501.
