RE: Cancellation of Administrative Approval AIO 1.006 (Well DIU 1-15/P25)

Dear Mr. Rossberg:

The Commission has corrected the Administrative Approval to reflect the correct well number.

Pursuant to BP Exploration (Alaska), Inc. (BPXA)'s request dated February 25, 2008 Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (AOGCC) hereby cancels Administrative Approval AIO 1.006, which allows continued gas injection in Duck Island Unit ("DIU") well 1-15/P25. This well exhibited tubing by inner annulus communication and BPXA did not at the time propose repairing the well to eliminate the problem. The Commission determined that gas injection could safely continue in the well, but subject to a number of restrictive conditions set out in the administrative approval.

BPXA has since shut in DIU 1-15/P25 after failing a Commission-witnessed mechanical integrity test on February 15, 2008. BPXA will not operate the injection well until repaired. Consequently, Administrative Approval AIO 1.006 no longer applies to operation of this well. Instead, injection into DIU 1-15/P25 will be governed by provisions of the underlying AIO No. 1.


