Dear Mr. Adegbola:

By letter dated May 6, 2015, ConocoPhillips Alaska, Inc. (CPAI) requested administrative approval to extend the expiration date contained in Rule 11 of area injection order (AIO) 21A (Amended) by six months.

In accordance with Rule 10 of AIO 021A (Amended), the Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (AOGCC) hereby **GRANTS** CPAI's request for administrative approval to extend the expiration date contained in Rule 11 of AIO 21A (Amended) by six months.

CPAI has applied for modifications to AIO 21A (Amended) and the AOGCC has scheduled a hearing on this application for July 9, 2015. AIO 21A (Amended) is currently scheduled to expire on May 16, 2015, in order to not interrupt operations before the AOGCC can hold the scheduled hearing and issue an order on CPAI's request extending the expiration date contained in Rule 11 of AIO 21A (Amended) is prudent.

Now therefore it is **ORDERED**:

Rule 11 of AIO 21A (Amended) is revised to read as follows:

Rule 11 Expiration Date.

This order shall expire on November 16, 2015.

RECONSIDERATION AND APPEAL NOTICE

As provided in AS 31.05.080(a), within **20** days after written notice of the entry of this order or decision, or such further time as the AOGCC grants for good cause shown, a person affected by it may file with the AOGCC an application for reconsideration of the matter determined by it. If the notice was mailed, then the period of time shall be **23** days. An application for reconsideration must set out the respect in which the order or decision is believed to be erroneous.

The AOGCC shall grant or refuse the application for reconsideration in whole or in part within 10 days after it is filed. Failure to act on it within 10-days is a denial of reconsideration. If the AOGCC denies reconsideration, upon denial, this order or decision and the denial of reconsideration are **FINAL** and may be appealed to superior court. The appeal **MUST** be filed within **33** days after the date on which the AOGCC mails, **OR 30** days if the AOGCC otherwise distributes, the order or decision denying reconsideration, **UNLESS** the denial is by inaction, in which case the appeal **MUST** be filed within **40** days after the date on which the application for reconsideration was filed.

If the AOGCC grants an application for reconsideration, this order or decision does not become final. Rather, the order or decision on reconsideration will be the **FINAL** order or decision of the AOGCC, and it may be appealed to superior court. That appeal **MUST** be filed within **33** days after the date on which the AOGCC mails, **OR 30** days if the AOGCC otherwise distributes, the order or decision on reconsideration.

In computing a period of time above, the date of the event or default after which the designated period begins to run is not included in the period; the last day of the period is included, unless it falls on a weekend or state holiday, in which event the period runs until 5:00 p.m. on the next day that does not fall on a weekend or state holiday.
