Dear Ms. Loveland:

Pursuant to ConocoPhillips Alaska Inc. (CPAI)'s request dated June 30, 2012 the Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (AOGCC) hereby cancels Administrative Approval AIO 2B.062, which allows continued water injection in Kuparuk River Unit well 2T-10. This well exhibited communication from the surface casing to the formation by a shallow casing leak. CPAI did not at the time propose repairs to eliminate the problem since competent tubing, packer, and production casing were demonstrated. The AOGCC determined that water injection could safely continue in the well, but subject to a number of restrictive conditions set out in the administrative approval.


Sundry application 312-132 was approved by AOGCC on April 10, 2012 to suspend Kuparuk River Unit 2T-10 until a workover or abandonment can be completed. On May 12, 2012, CPAI installed a composite bridge plug in the tubing to suspend the well. Based on the information provided, Administrative Approval AIO 2B.062 no longer applies to operation of this well.
