The Commission has corrected the Administrative Approval to reflect the correct Pool name.


Pursuant to BP Exploration (Alaska) Inc. (BPXA)'s request dated October 27, 2009 Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (AOGCC) hereby cancels Administrative Approval AIO 3.021, which allows continued water injection in Prudhoe Bay Unit (PBU) well Z-25. This well exhibited tubing by inner annulus communication and BPXA did not at the time propose repairing the well to eliminate the problem. The Commission determined that water injection could safely continue in the well, but subject to a number of restrictive conditions set out in the administrative approval.

BPXA has since performed a workover and replaced the tubing in PBU Z-25. A standard MITTIA was successfully accomplished after setting the new packer. Consequently, Administrative Approval AIO 3.021 no longer applies to operation of this well. Instead, injection into PBU P-Z-25 will be governed by provisions of the underlying AIO No. 3.
