RE: Cancellation of Administrative Approval AIO 004C.007 (Well PBU 14-01A)

Dear Mr. Rossberg:

In response to the BP Exploration (Alaska) Inc. ("BPXA") request dated November 16, 2005, the Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("Commission") hereby cancels Administrative Approval AIO 004C.007, which allows water injection in well PBU 14-01A. This well exhibited one competent pressure barrier and a second pressure barrier with a low but measurable leak rate, and BPXA did not at the time propose repairing the well to eliminate the pressure communication. The Commission determined that water injection could safely continue in the well, but subject to a number of restrictive conditions set out in the administrative approval.

Since that time, BPXA has determined that PBU 14-01A's condition has deteriorated to the point that safe operation is no longer supported. The well is and will remain shut in while repair options are evaluated. Consequently, Administrative Approval AIO 004C.007 no longer applies to operation of this well. Instead, injection in well PBU 14-01A will again be governed by provisions of the underlying Area Injection Order No. 4C.
