RE: Cancellation of Administrative Approval AIO 04E.001 (Well PBU 16-11)


Dear Ms. Dube:

Pursuant to BPXA's request dated April 19, 2007 AOGCC hereby cancels Administrative Approval AIO 04E.001, which allows continued water injection. This well exhibited production casing pressure communication, and BPXA did not at the time propose repairing the well to eliminate the problem. The Commission determined that water injection could safely continue in the well, but subject to a number of restrictive conditions set out in the administrative approval.


Since then, BPXA has determined that the condition of PBU 16-11 is inconsistent with their internal Well Integrity System policy. The well is shut in awaiting a rig work over. Consequently, Administrative Approval AIO 04E.001 no longer applies to operation of this well. Instead, injection in well PBU 16-11 will be governed by provisions of the underlying Area Injection Order No. 4E.


