RE: Cancellation of Administrative Approval AIO 04E.002 (Well Lisburne P2-15)




Pursuant to BPXA's request dated October 10, 2006 AOGCC hereby cancels Administrative Approval AIO 04E.002, which allows water injection in well Lisburne P2-15. This well exhibited a surface casing leak, and BPXA did not at the time propose repairing the well to eliminate the problem. The Commission determined that water injection could safely continue in the well, but subject to a number of restrictive conditions set out in the administrative approval.

Since then, BPXA has determined that Lisburne P2-15's condition has deteriorated to the point that safe operation is no longer supported. The well will remain shut in for evaluation of repair options. Consequently, Administrative Approval AIO 04E.002 no longer applies to operation of this well. Instead, injection in well Lisburne P2-15 will be governed by provisions of the underlying Area Injection Order No. 3.
