RE: Cancellation of Administrative Approval AIO 4E.003 (Well PBU AGI-05)

Dear Mr. Cismoski:

Pursuant to BP Exploration (Alaska) Inc. (BPXA)'s request dated December 16, 2010, the Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (Commission) hereby cancels Administrative Approval AIO 4E.003, which allows continued gas injection in Prudhoe Bay Unit ("PBU") well AGI-05. This well exhibited inner annulus repressurization that could be safely managed with periodic pressure bleeds and BPXA did not at the time propose repairing the well to eliminate the problem. The Commission determined that gas injection could safely continue in the well, but subject to a number of restrictive conditions set out in the administrative approval.


No IA repressurization has been evident since replacement and successful testing of the sub-surface safety valve on January 22, 2010. The well successfully passed an MIT-IA on September 20, 2010. Consequently, Administrative Approval AIO 4E.003 no longer applies to operation of this well. Instead, injection into PBU AGI-05 will be governed by provisions of the underlying AIO No. 4E.
