Dear Mr. Cismoski:

Pursuant to BPXA's request dated July 10, 2012 the Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (AOGCC) hereby cancels Administrative Approval AIO 04E.006, which allows gas injection in well PBU NGI-10. This well exhibited IA x OA pressure communication, and BPXA did not at the time propose repairing the well to eliminate the problem. The Commission determined that gas injection could safely continue in the well, but subject to a number of restrictive conditions set out in the administrative approval.

Sundry application 311-174 was approved by AOGCC on May 25, 2011 to cut and pull 9-5/8" casing, replace and fully cement 9-5/8" casing to surface, and run new 7-5/8' x 7" tubing. The rig work-over was completed on December 27, 2011 and the well was returned to gas injection at the end of February, 2012. Since then, BPXA has determined that PBU NGI-10 no longer exhibits IA x OA communication and this was confirmed with a passing AOGCC witnessed MITIA on March 12, 2012. Based on the information provided, Administrative Approval AIO 04E.006 no longer applies to operation of this well. Instead, injection in well PBU NGI-10 will be governed by provisions of the underlying Area Injection Order No. 4E.
