RE: Cancellation of Administrative Approval AIO 6.006

Dear Mr. Martin:

Pursuant to Chevron's request dated January 30, 2008 Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("AOGCC") hereby cancels Administrative Approval AIO 6.006, which allows continued water injection in Granite Point State 18742 Well 32RD located on the Anna Platform, Granite Point Field, offshore Cook Inlet. This well was completed as a production well without a packer and later converted to injection. Chevron did not at the time propose repairing the well to install a packer to eliminate tubing by inner annulus communication. The Commission determined that water injection could safely continue in the well, but subject to a number of restrictive conditions set out in the administrative approval.

Chevron has since shut in Well 32RD and has no plans to place back on injection. Instead, Chevron plans to plug and abandon the existing wellbore in preparation for a redrill and completion as an oil producer. Consequently, Administrative Approval AIO 6.006 no longer applies to operation of this well.
