RE: Cancellation of Administrative Approval AIO 1.003 (Well DIU 2-54/Q12)

Dear Mr. Rossberg:

Pursuant to BPXA's request dated February 22, 2007 AOGCC hereby cancels Administrative Approval AIO 1.003, which allows water injection in Endicott well 2-54/Q12 within the Duck Island Unit ("DIU"). This well exhibited tubing by inner annulus pressure communication, and BPXA did not at the time propose repairing the well to eliminate the problem. The Commission determined that water injection could safely continue in the well, but subject to a number of restrictive conditions set out in the administrative approval.


Since then, BPXA has shut in the well awaiting a rig work over to replace the tubing. Consequently, Administrative Approval AIO 1.003 no longer applies to operation of this well. Instead, injection in well DIU 2-54/Q12 will be governed by provisions of the underlying Area Injection Order No. 1.
