Dear Ms. Loveland:

Pursuant to ConocoPhillips Alaska Inc. (CPAI)'s request dated August 2, 2009 the Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (Commission) hereby cancels Administrative Approval AIO 2B.032, which allows continued water injection in Kuparuk River Unit (KRU) well 2U-04. This well exhibited a surface casing leak and CPAI did not at the time propose repairing the well to eliminate the problem. The Commission determined that water injection could safely continue in the well, but subject to a number of restrictive conditions set out in the administrative approval.

CPAI has since repaired the surface casing leak with a welded steel sleeve. Results from a surface casing integrity test (post-repair) were provided by CPAI in support of their request to cancel the administrative approval. Based on the information provided, Administrative Approval AIO 2B.032 no longer applies to operation of this well. Instead, injection into KRU 2U-04 will be governed by provisions of the underlying AIO No. 2B.
