Dear Mr. Walters:

Pursuant to ConocoPhillips Alaska Inc. (CPAI)'s request dated January 3, 2009 the Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (Commission) hereby cancels Administrative Approval AIO 2B.008, which allows continued water injection in Kuparuk River Unit (KRU) well 3A-06. This well exhibited tubing by inner annulus communication and CPAI did not at the time propose repairing the well to eliminate the problem. The Commission determined that water injection could safely continue in the well, but subject to a number of restrictive conditions set out in the administrative approval.

CPAI has since performed a rig workover to replace the production tubing, packer and wellhead packoffs. Results from wellhead pressure data monitoring and a passing mechanical integrity test of the inner annulus (post-repair) were provided by CPAI in support of their request to cancel the administrative approval. Based on the information provided, Administrative Approval AIO 2B.008 no longer applies to operation of this well. Instead, injection into KRU 3A-06 will be governed by provisions of the underlying AIO No. 2B.
