Dear Mr. Rossberg:

Pursuant to BP Exploration (Alaska) Inc. (BPXA)'s request dated October 27, 2009 Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (Commission) hereby cancels Administrative Approval AIO 3.015, which allows continued water injection in Prudhoe Bay Unit (PBU) well P-06B. This well exhibited tubing by inner annulus communication and BPXA did not at the time propose repairing the well to eliminate the problem. The Commission determined that water injection could safely continue in the well, but subject to a number of restrictive conditions set out in the administrative approval.


BPXA has since performed a well intervention to install a new dummy gas lift valve with in PBU P-06B. BPXA provided wellhead pressure data demonstrating the elimination of tubing by inner annulus pressure communication while injecting miscible gas. Consequently, Administrative Approval AIO 3.015 no longer applies to operation of this well. Instead, injection into PBU P-06B will be governed by provisions of the underlying AIO No. 3.


