
Pursuant to BP Exploration Alaska Inc. (BPXA)'s request dated February 20, 2012 the Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (AOGCC) hereby cancels Administrative Approval AIO 4E.008, which allows continued gas injection in Prudhoe Bay Unit well WGI-06. This well exhibited tubing by inner annulus communication that was manageable with period pressure bleeds. BPXA did not at the time propose repairing the well to eliminate the problem. The AOGCC determined that gas injection could safely continue in the well, but subject to a number of restrictive conditions set out in the administrative approval.

On December 18, 2010, BPXA completed repairs to the well by replacing the production tubing. AOGCC witnessed a passing mechanical integrity test on May 13, 2011 for Prudhoe Bay Unit WGI-06. Well pressures monitored daily and reported to the AOGCC monthly as required by AIO 4E.008 confirm the tubing-inner annulus communication has been eliminated. Based on the information provided, Administrative Approval AIO 4E.008 no longer applies to operation of this well. Instead, gas injection into Prudhoe Bay Unit WGI-06 will be governed by provisions of the underlying AIO No. 4E.


