Dear Mr. Barron:

This is in response your written request dated October 9, 1998, to make permanent the conditions allowed in DIO 13.1, approved May 15, 1998. DIO 13.1 amended Rule 4 "Operational Criteria" of DIO 13 to allow disposal of higher annual volumes of disposal fluids. We evaluated the data you submitted in your September 23 report, which provided information on disposal operations from April through August of 1998. Therefore as provided by "Rule 6 Administrative Relief" Rule 4 is amended as follows:

Rule 4 Operational Criteria

Average daily disposal rates shall not exceed 200 bbls/d and maximum disposal rates shall not exceed 300 bbls/d. Maximum disposal injection surface pressure in NTBU S-4 shall not exceed 1000 psi.

This approval is based upon well S-4 serving as a backup disposal well to well S-5. Should well S-4 become the primary disposal well, the Commission reserves the right to reconsider this decision.


