Dear Mr. Carlson:

By letter dated June 17, 2002, Forest Oil Corporation (“Forest”) requested authorization to dispose of storm water collected in the deck drain system of the Osprey platform in the Redoubt Unit #D1 disposal well. The estimated annual volume of storm water is approximately 3500 barrels, which represents the annual precipitation over the area of the platform.

The Commission has determined that the storm water collected in the drain system of the Osprey Platform is suitable for disposal in the RU #D1 well and is the preferred alternative to discharge overboard from the platform. Therefore, as provided by Rule 6 – Administrative Action, the Commission approves Forest’s request for authorization to dispose of storm water collected in the deck drain system of the Osprey Platform in the Redoubt Unit #D1 disposal well.
