Joshua Arvidson, Presenter. Mr. Arvidson, MSS, is the Co-Founder and Director of the Alaska Child Trauma Center at ACMHS and the Associate Director for the Pacific Northwest Trauma Training and Technical Assistance Center for SAMHSA's Complex Trauma Treatment Network. Joshua has directed research on complex trauma intervention publishing Alaska's first clinical outcomes study on complex trauma intervention with young children in 2011 in the Journal of Child and Adolescent Trauma. Joshua is currently a co-investigator for the DSMV field trial for developmental trauma disorder. Joshua is an adjunct instructor for the University of Alaska's School of Social Work. Joshua has presented at over 20 conferences including invited presentations on complex traumatic stress and treatment for complex trauma for the International Society for Traumatic Stress Studies and the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Service Administration's Annual Child Traumatic Stress Conference. Joshua has provided training and technical assistance to trauma multi-agency, regional and statewide trauma initiatives in Vermont, Illinois, California, Louisiana and British Columbia and is the Project Director for the Alaska Trauma-Informed Training Initiative.
