**NON-MANDATORY CONTRACT FOR STATE AGENCIES AND
 POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS**

In order to use a contract, the state must sign a Participating Addendum (PA). If the state has not signed a Participating Addendum for one of the vendors listed in the table below and you would like to work with that vendor, please notify the Contracting Officer listed at the bottom of this page.

NASPO ValuePoint has multiple non-mandatory contracts with qualified public safety communication product manufacturers who will supply a radio equipment for qualified NASPO ValuePoint contract purchases.

PLACING ORDERS: With most contractors, agencies have the option to place orders via phone, fax, or online. Always identify the Price Agreement Number to receive the contracted discount.

STATE AGENCIES: Ordering Instructions

- 1) Requestor submits product specifications to OIT for approval as an [SDM Ticket Request](#)
- 2) OIT will respond with permission to Requestor to order item directly from vendor
- 3) Requestor will order item through IRIS Master Agreement (MA 160000187)
 - a. Requestor will ship item to OIT to test, program, and inventory:

- 4) OIT will send notification to Requestor when item has been received.
- 5) OIT will test, program, and inventory item, then forward item on to Requestor.
- 6) Requestor sends notification to OIT that they have received item.
