Subject: February 2021 collective bargaining update with the Alaska Correctional Officers Association (ACOA).

Introduction:

The purpose of this memo is to increase public awareness of State operations as it relates to the collective bargaining process. The State and ACOA agreed to monthly updates on the status of negotiations for the public's awareness.

During the month of January, the State proposed language changes in 9 articles intended to increase efficiencies and reduce the cost of State government. ACOA did not make any written proposals nor was any article tentatively agreed upon in January between the parties.¹

Bargaining Dates:

During the month of January, the State's bargaining team met virtually with ACOA on January 11th and 28th.

A future bargaining session has been set for February 8th.

Proposals Exchanged:

Please note, the State makes proposals encompassing entire articles while ACOA made separate proposals on individual sub-sections of articles they would like to change.

During the month of January 2021, the State proposed changes for:
